2019 Season Long Points Race

Again, this year, in addition to the \$90 membership dues and the \$20 township discount option, you will have the opportunity to enter the season long points race. This fee must be paid before the start of the first tournament of the year. If you pay your \$10 fee in addition to your normal dues, you will receive points for participation in every regular event that you tee it up in. Points will be awarded as follows:

Any members who have decided not to participate in this points race will forfeit their points for each tournament. EX. If Marshall Rase (who chose not to enter the points race) wins the spring individual tournament and Derick Fritchey (who chose to enter the points race) finishes second, Marshall will receive 0 points while Derick will receive 10 points as he would be the highest finishing player that is participating. This will continue throughout the field until we get the highest 3 finishers gross/net for each flight that are in the points race. The same rules would apply for two or four man events. We will add up total points for all regular and optional AMGA events from April through September. Participation points are awarded to players that compete and turn in a valid scorecard. If a player is disqualified or chooses to not turn a card in, they will forfeit their points. We will take the top half of paid members and ties and will play the Points Championship Tournament on September 29th. EX. IF we have 100 paid entries in the points race, we would take the top 50 and ties for the tournament. In this tournament, we will have three flights based on handicap in which we will pay out gross and net. All prizes in this tournament will be cash.
